Walk the ancient route of the Roman Aqueduct, near Poundbury Tumulus and Fordington Bottom. Then cross fields to Maiden Castle and walk around most of the inner ridge of the hill fort. Return via Maiden Castle Road, the Rugby Ground and Poundbury. Note - Steep descent from Maiden Castle inner ridge - stick advised - can be avoided by slightly longer walk around all of inner ridge. Option to reduce walk by 1.2 miles by not doing Maiden Castle circuit, but this is the most spectacular part of the walk. One stile. Total ascent 535ft.
